

## How much will it cost?

£1.50 adult return and £1.00 child up to 16 return on Rural Rover.

£5.00 adult return on service 41/42 to Tewkesbury.

**Please note:** through ticketing unavailable at present. Fares to be paid to the connecting service driver and not to Rural Rover drivers.

Holders of concessionary bus passes can travel free from villages currently served by the 525 and 652 bus services: Bamfurlong, Barrow, Boddington, Elmstone Hardwick, Hardwicke and Staverton.

## How to book

You need to register with Third Sector Services to use Rural Rover. There is no registration fee.

To book your journey, simply call Third Sector Services on 0845 680 5029 between 8.00am and 4.00pm on the day before you travel. The booking line is open Monday to Friday. You can also tell the Rural Rover driver when you next want to travel.

When you book you will need to specify the day required, which village to pick you up from and where you intend to travel. You will be advised of the pick up place and time.

## When and where you can use Rural Rover



Please note that times shown are for guidance purposes only. You will be given a more precise time when you call Third Sector Services to reserve your place.

### Introducing the new Rural Rover

Rural Rover is a new community transport service provided on a not-for-profit basis which will serve the villages shown on the map from 4th April 2012. It replaces subsidised buses 525 and 652 serving those villages.

### Connecting you better in Gloucestershire

Rural Rover provides more opportunities for people to travel to Tewkesbury and Cheltenham for villages West of Cheltenham. Connections are provided on a Wednesday near Uckington for Tewkesbury.

Don't worry about missing your onward connection to Tewkesbury as the Rural Rover will get to the bus stop for the connecting service. Coming home, the connection will be guaranteed so even if the bus is running late, Rural Rover will wait. Rural Rover will not wait if you choose to catch a later bus.

### How will it work?

From 4th April 2012, Rural Rover will run on Wednesdays and Thursdays to Cheltenham and provide connections at Uckington for Tewkesbury. Communities served are:

Bamfurlong, Staverton, Barrow, Boddington, Elmstone Hardwicke and Hardwicke.

To use Rural Rover, you need to book in advance. Pick ups from local bus stops and agreed pick up points are between 10am and 11am, returning from Cheltenham to Uckington around 1.30pm. If you are travelling from Tewkesbury you will need to catch the 1.23pm number 41 bus (Boots, High Street) **at the very latest** to travel on Rural Rover to the villages listed.
